



All first and second grade students are invited to participate in Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW).

At 9:00 and 11:00 AM Mass, children are invited up to the steps, and given a blessing from the Priest. They are then escorted out of the Church to the West Meeting Room by their leaders. While in CLOW, children are mirroring what is happening in the sanctuary for the Liturgy of the Word. They return during the Preparation of the Gifts and offering.

Children's Liturgy of the Word Includes:

- Opening Prayer
- Bible Readings
- Discussion of Readings
- Profession of Faith
- Prayer of the Faithful
- Collection (their offering is presented on the Altar)

CLOW is meant for all first and second grade students in our Parish. It is a supplement to the religious education they are receiving in Faith Formation or in School. There is no registration and no cost—**there is room for all first and second grade students!**

We are excited to see your child(ren) continue to grow in their Faith, as they learn to *Know, Love, and Serve the Lord.*
