



## Preparing the Sunday Gospel—for October 8, 2017 Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

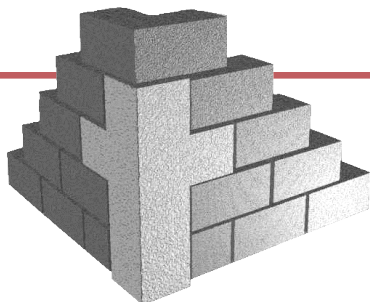
### Renters of a Vineyard

Proclaim: Mt. 21: 33-43



#### Questions/Process:

1. Jesus told a story about a landowner and his renters.
2. How do you think the landowner felt about how the renters treated his servants?
3. How do you think he felt about what they did to his son?
4. How do you think the landowner wanted his son to be treated? (*Well, respectfully, nicely, etc.*)
5. God sent his son to us. Who is God's son? (*Jesus*)
6. What did some people do to Jesus? How did they treat him? (*They crucified him, hung him on a cross, were mean to him*)
7. How do you think God wanted people to treat Jesus? (*Well, respectfully, nicely, etc.*)
8. How do you think Jesus wants us to treat others? (*Well, respectfully, nicely, etc.*)
9. What is one thing you can do this week to show you are a follower of Jesus?
10. Lead a prayer asking Jesus to help us to follow him and treat others as he would want us to treat them.
