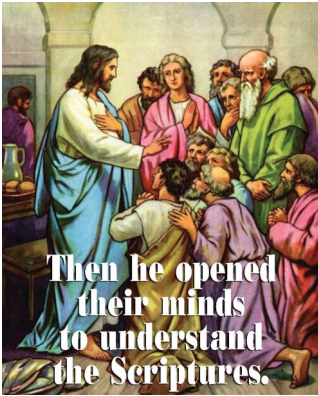




## Preparing the Sunday Gospel—for April 15, 2018 Third Sunday of Easter

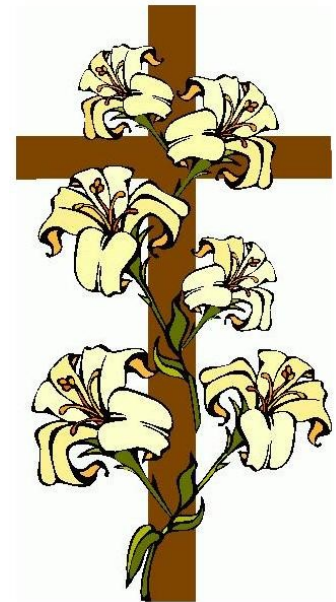


### Jesus Appears to His Disciples

Proclaim: Luke 24:35-48

#### Questions/Process:

1. How do you think people felt after Jesus died on the cross?
2. What happened while the two disciples were talking? (vs. 36)
3. What did Jesus say to them? (vs. 36)
4. How did the two disciples feel when Jesus appeared? (vs. 37)
5. How did Jesus respond to the fear of the disciples—what did he say and do? (vs. 38-40)
6. How did the disciples feel when they realized it was Jesus? (vs. 41)
7. How do you think you would have felt if you were there?
8. What helped them to believe it was Jesus? (vs. 41-43)
9. What does Jesus help them understand? (vs. 44)  
Explain that the Scriptures are the Bible.
10. What does Jesus say the Scriptures say about him? (vs. 46)
11. What message does he say should be preached? (vs. 47)
12. How can you show that you are sorry (repent) for your sins?
13. How can you be forgiving?
14. Think quietly: What is one thing you can do this week to show that you believe in Jesus and are forgiving?
15. Close by praying the Our Father then singing an Alleluia.
