



## Preparing the Sunday Gospel—for April 22, 2018 Fourth Sunday of Easter



### The Good Shepherd

Proclaim: John 10:11-18

#### Questions/Process:

1. Who does Jesus say he is? (vs. 11)
2. What is the Good Shepherd willing to do? (vs. 11)
3. How much does the Good Shepherd love and care for his sheep?
4. What does the hired man do—how does he care for the sheep? (vs. 12-13)
5. How well does the Good Shepherd know his sheep? Do the sheep know him? (vs. 14-15)
6. What does the Good Shepherd want to do for his sheep who are not in his pen? (vs. 16)
7. What will these sheep do once they are with the Good Shepherd? (vs. 16)
8. How many flocks and how many shepherds will there be? (vs. 16)
9. How do we show that we are following Jesus, the Good Shepherd?
10. Think quietly: What is one thing you can do this week to help you follow Jesus, the Good Shepherd?
11. What would you like to say to Jesus for being our Good Shepherd?
12. Close by praying the Our Father then singing the

refrain from “The Lord is My Shepherd” available on the FF OneDrive under Grades 1-6 and then Song Links.
