

Volunteer Ministry Position: Faith Formation Family Faith Night Catechist for Grades 1 – 6

Purpose: To share and teach the Good News of Jesus Christ and the Catholic faith tradition to children in Grades 1 – 6 in support of and with their families in place of their regular parent catechist on Family Faith Nights (FFN).

Responsible to: Coordinator of Grades 1 – 6 Faith Formation and the Faith Formation Resources Coordinator

Responsibilities:

- Be a caring, supportive, Catholic role model
- Attend required catechist meetings and training
- Prepare and teach weekly classes using the text provided as the core material to be taught
- Mutually agree with team FFN catechist on how responsibilities for classroom management will be shared
- Read and follow all communication from the coordinator in a timely fashion
- Report 15 – 30 minutes before session start to the Work Room in the Education Center office
- Before class, safety-check classroom. After class, pick up room, turn out the lights, and close the door
- Follow all Faith Formation policies, guidelines, procedures, and duties (see your folder)
- Greet and welcome the children and parents as they arrive for class.
- Take the students to their parents in Regan Hall for and assist with the FFN family session when appropriate
- Be present with your class at and participate in all large group or special gatherings during class.
- Assist with the Family Night of Prayer if able and available.
- Contact the coordinator in advance if you are unable to come for a scheduled class
- Seek to grow and learn through continuing education programs and personal formation
- Communicate with the coordinator about concerns regarding children, program, or facility
- Be conscious of student allergies and special needs as noted on the class list and student forms
- Report suspected child neglect or abuse to the coordinator and appropriate authorities confidentially

Qualifications/Skills:

- Practicing Catholic (attending Sunday Mass weekly, etc) who desires to nurture children in the faith
- Be current on background check and VIRTUS and Code of Conduct and Mandatory Reporting trainings
- Prompt, reliable, organized, flexible and patient
- Willing and able to work with others in the catechetical mission of the church
- Love of children and ability to work and relate well with them, including those with special needs
- Friendly and welcoming and possessing a sense of humor
- Desire to learn and grow in the Catholic faith
- Helpful, but not mandatory: Teaching experience or leadership with children

Time Required:

- Five sessions per school year, 1.25 hour each, plus Family Retreat Night, 1.5 hours if able and available
- Preparation for class, approximately 1 - 2 hours per lesson
- Attendance encouraged, but not mandatory at the Catechist and Classroom Assistant Trainings and Meetings: 4 - 5 per year, 1.25 – 2 hours each
- New Catechists: Mandatory VIRTUS training (3 hours) and online Code of Conduct/Mandatory Reporting training (1 hour); New catechist orientation and training
- All Catechists: Mandatory refresher trainings every 3 years

When and Where: Tuesdays, 6:00 – 7:15 pm or Wednesdays 5:30 – 6:45 pm in the St Vincent de Paul Education Center

Training/Support Provided:

- Mandatory: VIRTUS and online Code of Conduct/Mandatory Reporting training for new catechists; Online refresher trainings every 3 years
- Planning helps from print and web materials
- Smart board training and PowerPoint slides to use with the lesson plans in the catechist manual
- *Weekly Catechist Notes* and regular catechist and classroom assistant meetings and trainings
- Ongoing and seasonal ideas/supports (craft ideas, videos, story time, visits from priests, etc)
- Parish adult faith formation opportunities
- Personal and professional support of the coordinators regarding your questions, ideas, planning, etc
